

Intermountain PEAK Program at ASU

Your brighter future begins here! Intermountain Healthcare and Arizona State University have partnered to empower you to achieve your personal and professional goals by earning your degree online from ASU through the Intermountain PEAK (Path to Education, Advancement and Knowledge) Program.

Program Details

- This program is for Intermountain Healthcare employees and employee family members seeking an online **undergraduate** or **graduate** degree. For family members to maintain eligibility, Intermountain Healthcare employees must meet the following eligibility criteria:
 - Minimum 20 hours per week scheduled. Employed physicians and APPs are included if they work 20+ scheduled hours.
 - Available immediately with work rules applied. There is no wait period.
 - In good standing according to their Yearly Final Snapshot rating.
- Eligible dependents will receive up to \$5,250 per year in tuition coverage toward an eligible **undergraduate** or **graduate** degree.
- You'll be responsible for paying all remaining costs and fees, including the application fee, late fees, books, course materials and any travel associated with the program. To check the tuition and fees associated with your degree program, visit asuonline.asu.edu/what-it-costs.
- Eligibility in the program is dependent on the Intermountain Healthcare employee's eligibility. It is recommended that employees and family members stay in close contact regarding progress in the program and the employee's eligibility status.

How do I participate in the Intermountain PEAK Program at ASU?

- Log into intermountain.instride.com with the registration information your Intermountain Healthcare employee family member sent to you via email.
- Select a degree program and submit a request for information. An ASU enrollment coach will reach out to you.
- Apply to ASU and submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- If admitted to ASU, enroll in your courses.
- Your tuition benefit will appear in the Finances section of My ASU.
